Highly Intelligent Duplicate Bridge Software for Windows

Micro Bridge supports many types of duplicate bridge and functions that are useful for beginners, average players, and even experts. You can enjoy playing bridge with computer and human players as if you were in a tournament.

Fair Play Algorithms

The computer is a completely fair player and algorithms are based on the Monte Carlo Simulation Method. The computer randomly generates unknown hands under known conditions that are derived from information of the auction and defenders' signals. A computer player bids and plays well just like an experienced player.

Game Types

- **Practice:** You simply play each board respectively. The score is calculated based on duplicate scoring.
- **Team Match:** Your results are compared with the results of the Closed Room that is achieved by a computer parallel to your play. Two types of scoring methods (IMP and Board-a-Match scoring) are available.
- **Using Actual Tournament Data:** Your results are compared with actual results. Micro Bridge calculates your match points and decides your final ranking. Team match and three types of pairs tournament (Match-Point, IMP scoring, and IMPs against the datum) are supported.
- **Using PBN Files:** You can play Practice and Team Match, using PBN files (Portable Bridge Notation).

Actual Tournament Data

Micro Bridge contains over **10,000** boards of actual tournament data. Additional data disks are also available.

Network Support

- **LAN (Up to Four Persons):** You need two or more computers which share the same folder on the network.
- **Modem (Two Persons):** You can play with your human partner via a modem.
- **Direct Serial Link (Two Persons):** You can play with your human partner by connecting the serial ports of two computers with a serial cross cable (null-modem cable).

Pre-defined Bidding Systems

Fourteen fundamental bidding systems, including American, Danish, Dutch, English, Finnish, French, Japanese, and Swedish systems, are pre-defined.

- Fourth Best, Third Best and Lowest, Parity Leads
- Lead Options from AK, xxx, xxxx, and xxxxx.
- Zero or Two Higher Leads
